

CoolCram Demo for (70-080) IEAK 5.0

1. You are creating a customized package of Internet Explorer and related components, You include selected Web site addresses in the Favorites folder. You use the customized package to install Internet Explorer on all client computers in your company. You plan to add new Web site addresses to the Favorites folder on each client computer at regular intervals. You want to perform this task by using the least amount of administrative time as possible.

What should you do each time you want to add new Web site addresses to the Favorites folder?

- A. Use the IEAK Profile Manager to add the new Web site addresses to the automatic configuration file that is specified in each user's browser.
- B. Add a logon script to copy the new Web site addresses from a centralized server into the Temporary Internet Files folder of each client computer.
- C. Create a new customized package that includes the new Web site addresses. Instruct all users to select Synchronize from the Tools menu in Internet Explorer.
- D. Add the new Web site addresses to the Favorites folder on your company's HTTP server. Instruct all users to select Synchronize from the Tools menu in Internet Explorer.

2. You are a help desk technician for Coho Vineyard. Sophie, who works in the purchasing department reports that she has problems with her computer when she tries to complete online purchase orders for Just Togs. Sophie says that every time she completes an online purchase order at <http://www.justtogs.com>, she receives a message asking if she wants to submit this information over the Internet.

She has 20 purchase orders for Just Togs to complete this afternoon. She wants to know what she can do to prevent these messages from appearing.

How should Sophie configure her computer?

- A. Import a client authentication certificate for Just Togs.
- B. Add <http://www.justtogs.com> to the Trusted sites zone,
- C. Change the security level for the Local intranet zone to High.
- D. Remove <http://www.justtogs.com> from the Restricted sites zone.

3) The security officer for your company has notified you that three employees are using NetMeeting to share sensitive documents over the Internet. She wants you to change the configuration of NetMeeting to prevent the sharing of sensitive documents.

You must consider the following factors:

- 1. Your company uses user profiles.
- 2. All computers are set up to use the automatic configuration feature of Internet Explorer.
- 3. You want to make the minimum number of profile changes required.

Which action should you take to change the configuration of NetMeeting?
