1. Case question demo:

Background:

Hanson Brothers is a corporation that sells hair products. Hanson Brothers has its headquarters (HQ) in the United States, and has major subsidiaries (subs) in 10 different countries throughout the world.

Hanson Brothers wants to implement an executive information system (EIS). The EIS should let management at HQ and at all of the subs monitor the sales progress of all divisions of the company, across all subs.

Current System:

Management Information Systems (MIS) Manager:

Once a month, an administrative assistant at HQ spends a couple of days producing a sales report by copying the data from each of the subsidiaries' systems and pasting the data into a spreadsheet. The spreadsheet is then mailed to managers throughout the company.

Business Analyst:

The lowest level of the product hierarchy is the SKU. SKUs often represent the type of packaging used on a product. SKUs roll up into products, products roll up into product families, and product families roll up into product lines. HQ sales projections can be done at any of three levels: line, family, or product. Sales projections are not done at the SKU level, but SKU sales are tracked to measure the success of a particular packaging
